THE MCBA MITCHELL H. COBERT MENTOR PROGRAM



The Program:

- A Mentor and Protégé will be paired for a term of twelve months, consisting of at least eight in-person meetings and participation in specific events. Protégés will generally guide the process of the selection of their Mentor based on practice area, experience and/or other interests, subject to agreement by the Mentor, with the assistance of the Committee.
- The Mentor and Protégé each earn six (6) Continuing Legal Education (CLE) credits, two of which will be Ethics credits.
- The Mentor and Protégé pay an administrative fee of \$150.00 (for members of the MCBA) or \$200.00 (for non-members) due upon execution of a Mentoring Agreement.

Mentor Requirements:

- A lawyer admitted to the practice in New Jersey for at least 7 years and must not have received a disciplinary sanction within the past 5 years.
- Must have malpractice insurance coverage.
- Must read the *Principles of Professionalism* of the Commission on Professionalism in the Law, and any codes of conduct or civility promulgated by the Morris County Bar Association.
- Attend a training session offered by the Morris County Bar Association.

Protégé Requirements:

- A lawyer admitted to the practice in New Jersey for 5 years or less and be in good standing with the Clerk of the Supreme Court.
- Must have malpractice insurance coverage.
- Protégés can indicate the areas of interest in which they are seeking to be mentored, and the Committee will seek to match the Protégé with an appropriate Mentor. Participation by Protégés is confidential, and no Protégé information is shared outside of the Committee.
